





ATC experiences regular incidents all around the world, where pilots misinterpret the intent of the *UM79 CLEARED TO* [FIX2] **VIA** [FIX1] message, which is a multipoint clearance. This message is regularly confused with the *UM74 PROCEED DIRECT TO* [FIX], which is a single point clearance. Taking the "wrong" point can have serious consequences. CLEARED TO is technically impossible to be sent with a single fix, there are always multiple points involved.



Example: CLEARED TO EVADI[FIX2] VIA ALASA[FIX1]





Note: Some airframes display the message as CLEARED TO [FIX] VIA ROUTE CLEARANCE, which leads to regular misinterpretations. ALWAYS look for the additional points.

REMEMBER

CLEARED TO → always multiple points

PROCEED DIRECT TO → always a single point
