- ➤ SAFA ramp inspections allow for a continuous monitoring of operators
- ➤ SAFA Database is the tool for the information exchange and analysis
- ➤ A new version of the Database is live since 21 September 2011



#### Used for Exchange of information

- ➤ Web based application
- ➤ Storage of Ramp Inspection Reports
- ➤ Full access for each Participating State
  - inclusion of reports
  - retrieve data
- Exchange of information
- ➤ Stored information is confidential
- ➤ EASA does not own the data!

# Access to non-SAFA NAAs and to operators


- Access granted to Guest NAAs and to operators:
  - ➤ registered Guest NAAs have access limited to the reports of the operators for which they have regulatory oversight responsibilities
  - operators' access is limited to their own reports
    - Non-SAFA operators access can be obtained via the relevant Guest NAA in 2 steps:
      - ➤ The Guest NAA will give a first approval to the operator user
      - SAFA administrator will approve the access

# Access to non-SAFA NAAs and to operators

- ➤ Guest NAAs and operators are able to:
  - > retrieve their relevant reports
  - add information on follow-up actions taken
- An operator will be able to register only if there is a registered coordinator for its responsible NAA
- Therefore, if its country has not yet registered for SAFA, the operator will not be able to obtain access






## Information tab on Login

- Need to publish FAQs
- Administered by SAFA Coordination
- Selected items of SAFA Library are made public

### **Oversight inspectors**

- Requested by several States
- Access for inspectors assigned to oversee national carrier(s)
- Access limited to assigned carriers
- Will not see other SAFA data
- Can be RO or RW (for follow-up)
- Directly informed on new inspections
- Introduces read/write users for guest states





#### **Automatic disabling V2.0**


- Email receipt is of paramount importance
- Also indicator that user left organisation
- Previous system disabled accounts only after 30 days inactivity
- Email sent at disabling date often lost
- Enabling by coordinator only worked if user subsequently logged on before 4PM/4AM



#### **Automatic disabling V2.2**

- Email receipt is periodically tested
- Account is silently disabled 28 days <u>since</u> <u>last test</u>
- User administration shows "disabled-auto"
- Upon next logon, user is notified he/she is due for next Email test
- 1. Click link
- 2. Enter Email address (known by DB)
- 3. Click link in Email received in next minutes
