

Policy and advocacy

ERA's policy and advocacy work involves collaboration and interaction on behalf of our members with the institutions that drive Europe's strategic aviation policy, including EASA, the European Commission, Parliament and Council, EUROCONTROL, the SESAR entities, ECAC and individual states' transport authorities.

ERA has always been at the forefront of driving development across multiple different policy areas affecting members, building our positions based on members' input. We work as an outsourced government affairs department, saving members time, money and resources.

ERA works across a variety of topics, campaigning and lobbying on behalf of our members both proactively and reactively. Over the past year, ERA's Policy and Technical team has focussed particular efforts on managing the impact of the Coronavirus on our members. Our recent work areas have included:

- ✓ EU261 – passenger rights;
- ✓ restart of travel/EU Digital Covid Certificate implementation;
- ✓ slot waiver reviews;
- ✓ state aid and competition;
- ✓ airport charges;
- ✓ ticket distribution and CRS code of conduct;
- ✓ API/ PNR rules;

- ✓ environmental legislation;
- ✓ avionic equipage;
- ✓ Brexit;
- ✓ crisis management (including volcanic ash contingency);

ERA working groups

ERA's regular group meetings – on air safety, industry affairs, environmental and social affairs, operations, cargo and finance – are open exclusively for ERA members to attend. The groups offer the opportunity to exchange views and experiences and to network. They also deliver valuable learning opportunities, with input from expert member and external speakers, and provide a forum to raise issues with ERA's policy and technical team. Member input from these events is used to set the direction for our lobbying work and ensures we are working for the interests of all our members.





Publications

ERA produces a range of publications throughout the year on key topics and current campaigns, a bi-monthly magazine called Regional International – featuring high-profile interviews, market intelligence, the latest news and updates from our industry and member companies – and an annual Yearbook, a directory of all our members. These are distributed directly to members and high-profile industry figures as well as being available on our website. We encourage members to contribute to our publications to share their work and successes. There are also a variety of opportunities to advertise with us to further raise your company profile.
